A PD&E Study is prepared to determine social, economic and environmental impacts associated with a project. It is conducted to provide the following information:

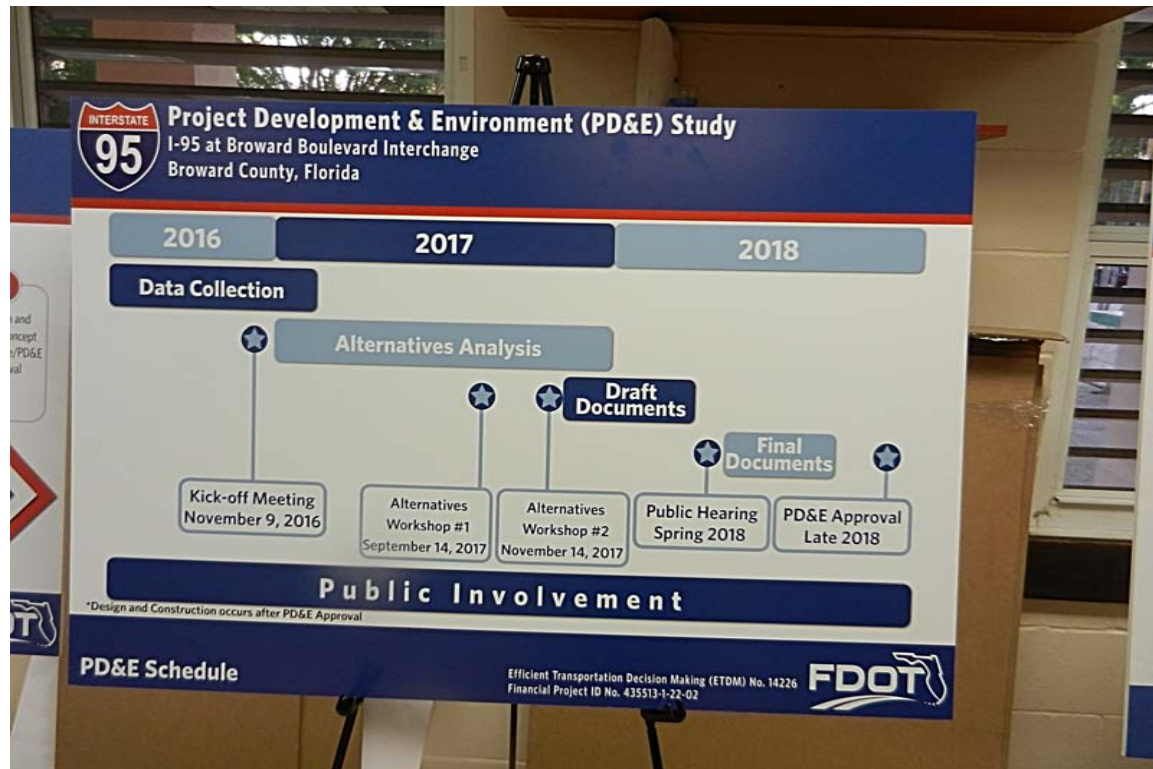
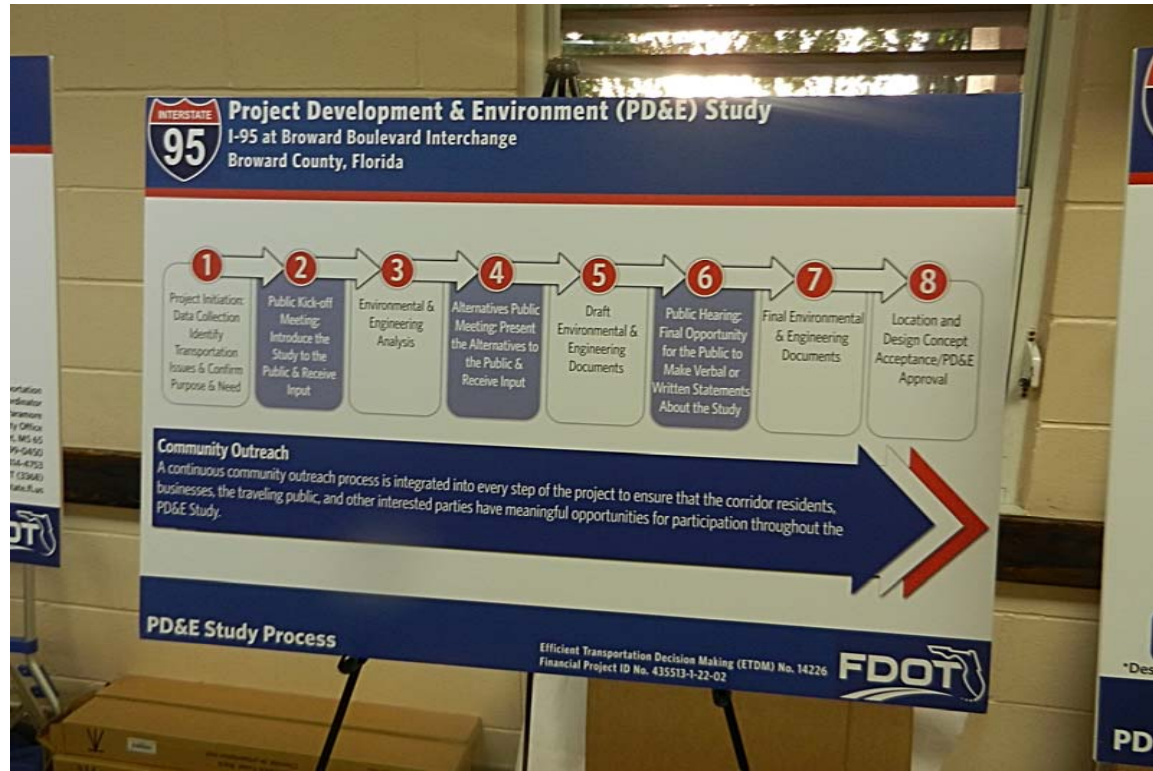
- Need for the project
